STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary for Clerks in the Office of Register of Probate in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. The last paragraph of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to York county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'York county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$4,000; for clerks in the office of register of probate. \$2,000 \$3,080; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$1,750.'
