STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Laurence Dresser, of Portland.

Laurence Dresser; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$151.25 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Laurence Dresser, of Portland, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on May 21, 1944 around 11 A. M. in the town of Gorham. The investigating warden was Maynard F. Marsh.
