STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Compensation of the County Commissioners of
Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 6, amended. That part of section 6 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to Penobscot county is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Penobscot, \$1,750, except that 1 member of the board to be designated by the board, who shall devote each full working day to his duties, including superintendence of the county buildings, shall receive annually the sum of \$2,000.’
