IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FIVE

**AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of the Municipal Court of
Portland.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. & S. L., 1891, c. 150, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 150 of the private and special laws of 1891, as amended by chapter 61 of the private and special laws of 1925, is hereby further amended to read as follows :

'**Sec. 3. Salary increased.** The salary of the judge of said court shall be ~~twenty-two hundred dollars~~ \$3,000 per annum, ~~payable quarterly,~~ beginning January 1st, 1945, in full for all services.'
