STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Recorder of the Portland Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1887, c. 274, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 274 of the private and special laws of 1887, as amended by chapter 21 of the private and special laws of 1937, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Salary of recorder. The salary of the recorder of the municipal court for the city of Portland shall be ~~\$1600~~ **\$2,400 per annum, beginning January 1st, 1945**, which shall be in full for all services, and it shall be the duty of said recorder to make and present all copies of libels and monitions in liquor cases.'
