AN ACT Relating to Maintenance on State Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 20, § 46, amended. The last paragraph of section 46 of chapter 20 is hereby amended to read as follows :

'The maintenance provisions of sections ~~43, 44, 45, 46, 58, 59, 61, and 66~~ shall not apply to those sections of state highway where houses are nearer than 200 feet apart for a distance of $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile in cities or towns whose population according to the last U. S. census exceeds 5,000 inhabitants, except as hereinafter provided for maintenance of secondary federal aid projects, and the The snow removal provisions of sections 43, 44, 45, 46, 58, 59, 61 and 66 shall not apply to those sections of state highway where houses are nearer than 200 feet apart for a distance of $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile in cities or towns whose population according to the last U. S. census exceeds 2,000 inhabitants.'
