STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Outdoor Advertising.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 20, § 115, repealed and replaced. Section 115 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and replaced, to read as follows:

'Sec. 115. Disposition of fees; expenses of commission. The fees collected under the provisions of sections 111 to 122, inclusive, shall be paid over by the commission to the treasurer of state and deposited in the highway fund. All the costs and expenses of the commission incurred in administering the provisions of sections 111 to 122, inclusive, shall be paid out of such amounts as the legislature may appropriate.'
