AN ACT Relating to Insurance for Children by Fraternal Beneficiary Societies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 56, § 181, amended. Section 181 of chapter 56 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 181. Child's certificate may be continued. In the event of the termination of membership in the society by the person responsible for the support of any child, on whose account a certificate may have been issued, as provided herein, the The benefit certificate as to any child may be continued for the benefit of the estate of the child, provided the contributions are continued, or for the benefit of any other person responsible for the support and maintenance of such child, who shall assume the payment of the required contributions.'
