AN ACT Relating to Yearly Fees for Boxers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 78, § 8, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 8 of chapter 78 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'All persons engaging in such boxing contests as boxers, seconds, managers, referees, judges, and physicians must have been licensed by the commission in a like manner, such licenses to be subject to revocation or suspension for cause. The yearly fees shall be as follows: boxers, ~~\$3~~ \$6; managers, \$5; seconds, \$2; referees, \$5; judges and physicians, no fee.'
