STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Mrs. Mattie Simmons, of Friendship.

Mrs. Mattie Simmons; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$154.80 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Mrs. Mattie Simmons, of Friendship, as a full and final settlement for her claim against the state for damage to her car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The accident occurred on September 18, 1943, in Cushing, while driving on route 220. William F. Davis was the investigating warden. Mrs. Simmons' car was damaged to the extent of left front light broken, grill stove in, windshield shattered and radiator split open.
