RESOLVE, Regulating Fly Fishing in Tributaries of Richardson Lake.

Fly fishing in tributaries of Richardson lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening portions of Metalluc brook, Mill brook and Mosquito brook, all tributaries of Upper Richardson lake in Oxford County, to fly fishing only from August 15th to September 30th with a daily bag limit of 4 fish; and be it further

Resolved: That the commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to erect proper markers to designate the limits within which such brooks are open to fly fishing.
