RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Advertise and Sell Certain Stumpage in the Town of Ashland.

Forest commissioner authorized to advertise and sell certain stumpage. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to advertise and sell certain stumpage on lots 45 and 48 in the north part of Sheridan, now a part of the town of Ashland.

. STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land is a part of the original public domain which never was sold; 65% of the stand of timber is birch, the remainder being maple and poplar. This stumpage is needed in the war effort and the birch should be cut because of threatened attack from the bronze birch borer.
