# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Snow Removal.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 20, § 59, amended. The last sentence of section 59 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The towns shall sand the aforementioned state aid highways, 3rd class highways, and town ways to the satisfaction of the highway commission, and in case the towns fail to sand the highways to the satisfaction of the highway commission, the said commission shall be authorized to make arrangements for the proper sanding and the cost of such sanding done by the highway commission shall be deducted from the state's reimbursement to the towns paid by the towns.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 20, § 61, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 61 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'All pay-rolls for the season's snow removal work, on routes designated in section 58, are to be received at the office of the commission monthly, on or before the 15th day of each month, and a final pay-roll on or before May 1st, following the winter in which this work is done.'
