RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Penobscot County to Mrs. Elizabeth Hatch, of Old Town.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Mrs. Elizabeth Hatch, of Old Town, whatever interest the state has in lot 35, River lots 7 and 8, east of main highway in Argyle township, Penobscot county, containing 20 acres more or less, for the sum of \$22.11.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

These tracts of land were sold November 25, 1942 for 1940 taxes. Mrs. Hatch wishes to purchase this property for the sum of \$22.11 which is the amount of back taxes, interest and cost. This amount has been deposited with the treasurer of state.
