RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Lincolnville.

Town of Lincolnville; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$1,622.09 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Lincolnville, to reimburse said town for expenses incurred in employing the state guard in fighting forest fires in said town of Lincolnville; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The services of the state guard were required to fight forest fires from May 20, 1944 to May 23, 1944. The town of Lincolnville has never been reimbursed for such expense.
