RESOLVE, in Favor of Clement P. Seavey of Scarborough.

Clement P. Seavey; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Clement P. Seavey, of Scarborough, the sum of \$349.41 to reimburse him for damage done to his 1941 heavy-duty Ford truck because of non-repair of a state aid road; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Seavey was delivering gravel to the So. Portland shipyard when his truck struck a hole in state aid road, leading from Cumberland Center to M. C. R. R. station in Cumberland, and was thrown off the road, causing severe damage to his truck. The road had been neglected to be repaired after the highway commission had been notified several times by the selectmen of the town of Cumberland.
