AN ACT to Simplify Payments by Employees' Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 60, § 12, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 12 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'**III.** The treasurer of state shall be the custodian of the several funds of the retirement system. Upon receipt of vouchers signed by ~~z~~ **a person or** persons designated by the board of trustees, the state controller shall draw a warrant on the treasurer of state for the amounts so authorized. A duly attested copy of the resolution of the board of trustees designating such persons and bearing on its face specimen signatures of such persons shall be filed with the state controller as his authority for making payments upon such vouchers. ~~No voucher shall be drawn unless it has previously been authorized by resolution by the board of trustees.~~
