RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Penobscot County to John Sharpe, of Argyle.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to John Sharpe, of Argyle, whatever interest the state has in a lot in lot 64, River lot 14, in Argyle township, Penobscot county, containing 50 acres more or less, for the sum of \$43.77.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Sharpe has paid \$43.77 the amount of taxes, interest and costs so that he may redeem his property which was sold to the forest commissioner for taxes.
