RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Penobscot County to George E. Burns, of Argyle.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to George E. Burns, of Argyle, whatever interest the state has in land in Argyle known as the No. 454 Oronoco Grange property, for the sum of \$150.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

These tracts of land were sold November 25, 1942 for 1940 taxes. Mr. Burns wishes to purchase this property for the above mentioned sum which is the amount of back taxes, interest and cost. This amount has been deposited with the treasurer of state.'
