**AN ACT to Authorize Searles F. Clement to Practice Veterinary Surgery,
Medicine, and Dentistry.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Searles F. Clement authorized to practice veterinary surgery, medicine and dentistry. Searles F. Clement of Levant, in the county of Penobscot, and state of Maine, is hereby authorized to practice veterinary surgery, medicine or dentistry in this state upon paying the annual license fee to the state required of registered practitioners of veterinary surgery, medicine or dentistry, provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall permit said Searles F. Clement to attach to his name the title "V. S." or "Veterinary Surgeon" or any veterinary title ordinarily used, and the privilege of practicing veterinary surgery, medicine or dentistry by said Clement shall extend only to the practice of the same upon animals belonging to persons summoning him for the purpose, knowing him not to be registered therefor as provided in section 5 of chapter 70 of the revised statutes.
