RESOLVE, in Favor of Donald S. White, of Ludlow.

Donald S. White; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$300 from the appropriation for the department of inland fisheries and game to be paid to Donald S. White, of Ludlow, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his oats by bears.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Five acres of oats were trampled by bears in the summer of 1943, causing a damage and loss of 200 bushels at \$1.50 per bushel.
