AN ACT Relating to Towns Having No Free High Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 96, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 96 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'When the amount to be paid under the contract shall equal or exceed the income of the academy for the preceding year, exclusive of sums paid said academy by the contracting town, a joint committee ~~shall~~ **may** be formed consisting of the superintending school committee of said town and an equal number of the trustees of the academy.'
