RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in South Bog Stream.

Fishing in South Bog stream, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation limiting South Bog stream and tributaries in Franklin county, a tributary of Rangeley lake, to fly fishing only, from April 15th to September 30th, with a daily bag limit of 4 fish per person in the aggregate.
