AN ACT Relative to the Salary of the Judge of the Brunswick Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1903, c. 277, § 11, amended. Section 11 of chapter 277 of the private and special laws of 1903, as amended by chapter 108 of the private and special laws of 1927, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 11. Salary of judge. The judge of said court shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$1,000~~ \$1,500 in full for all services, **beginning April 1st, 1945**, payable quarterly on the last days of March, June, September and December from the treasury of Cumberland county.'
