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**RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Donald Wilson,  
of Bath.**

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**Donald Wilson; state pension increased. Resolved:** That a pension of \$30 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Donald Wilson, of Bath, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Said pension shall begin July 1, 1945, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

That part of chapter 145 of the resolves of 1941 which provides for a state pension for Donald Wilson, of Bath, is hereby repealed.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Wilson is a cripple, unable to work. His mother is also an invalid.  
Mr. Wilson is now receiving \$12 per month which is insufficient.
