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**RESOLVE, Permitting Examination of William J. Brasier by State Board  
of Examiners of Funeral Directors and Embalmers.**

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**William J. Brasier; special examination. Resolved:** That the state board of examiners of funeral directors and embalmers is hereby authorized and directed to give a theoretical examination to William J. Brasier, of Portland, to test his practical ability to practice the profession of embalming, and his knowledge of the embalming laws. In case he passes the said examination, he shall be entitled to practice embalming in this state, upon the payment of the usual license fee required of licensed embalmers.
