AN ACT Relative to Game Preserve.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 33, § 90-A, additional. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 90-A and to read as follows :

'Commissioner empowered to create temporary game preserves in limited area. The commissioner is empowered, upon the written consent of land-owners, to create from any lands within the state, not to exceed 1,000 acres, a game preserve, or preserves, for the purpose of liberating tame deer. The commissioner is also authorized to release all, or any part of such lands from the restrictions of a game preserve, or preserves, whenever he deems it expedient.'
