RESOLVE, Opening Pennessewassee Lake to Smelt Fishing.

Pennessewassee lake opened to smelt fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby authorized and directed to open Pennessewassee lake and Little Pennessewassee lake, together with the tributaries thereto, in Oxford county, to smelt fishing during the regular smelting season.
