STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Noncontributory Pension Status of Anna F.

Crowley of Biddeford.

Credit given Anna F. Crowley. Resolved: That Anna F. Crowley of Biddeford be given credit for 8 full years of teaching service rendered in Thornton academy and such additional service, as she may hereafter render in said institution, to be applied toward meeting requirements for a noncontributory teacher's pension.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Miss Crowley has had 22 years of regular teaching service in the public schools of Biddeford. For the past 8 years she has been teaching full time in Thornton academy, a secondary school located in the city of Saco. She petitions the legislature to be given full credit for these 8 full years of service, plus any additional service which she may render in this institution, toward fulfilling requirements for a noncontributory teacher's pension.
