RESOLVE, in Favor of George Currier, of Norway.

George Currier; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$100 from the appropriation for the department of inland fisheries and game to be paid to George Currier, of Norway, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his bean crop by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Currier's bean crop was destroyed by deer in 1943 for which damage he has received no reimbursement.
