RESOLVE, in Favor of Fay F. Mattatall, of Ellsworth.

Fay F. Mattatall; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$50 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Fay F. Mattatall, of Ellsworth, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The accident occurred on December 17, 1944 in the town of Ellsworth. The car was damaged to the extent of right front window broken, chrome broken on front and rear door handles, small dents in front and rear doors, dent in right rear fender.
