RESOLVE, in Favor of Donald H. Tate, of Ellsworth Falls.

Donald H. Tate; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$61.51 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Donald H. Tate, of Ellsworth Falls, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The accident happened on December 1, 1943 in the town of Ellsworth. Game Warden Fred G. Smith investigated. The car was damaged as follows: right headlight assembly broken, right fender bent, right engine hood handle bent, radiator core broken, grill bent.
