STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Mrs. Della M. Philbrook of West Enfield.

Mrs. Della M. Philbrook; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$2,000 to be paid to Mrs. Della M. Philbrook, of West Enfield, as a full and final settlement against the state for damage to her farm by water flowage caused by the building of a new highway in the town of Enfield; said sum to be paid from the state highway fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

When the state highway commission built a new road in Enfield it caused water flowage on Mrs. Philbrook's farm. All the flat land was under water and ice which killed the grass roots, therefore causing Mrs. Philbrook to lose between 30 and 35 tons of hay which sells for \$40 per ton.
