RESOLVE, in Favor of John H. Perkins of Brunswick.

Screening private pond. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting John H. Perkins of Brunswick, in the county of Cumberland, to place fish screens at the entrance and exit of the privately constructed pond located on his land. The pond was constructed by damming the small stream known as Thompson's brook and said screens shall be placed therein under the supervision of the commissioner of inland fisheries and game.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The dam is constructed a short distance from the southern side of U. S. highway # 1 where Thompson's brook crosses beneath said highway. The pond is on the property of said John Perkins and only one land owner above the pond would be affected by the screens placed in the pond. This land owner has no objections. Above this land owner is a pond owned by the Bath Water District but this pond would not be affected as a permanent dam constructed by them completely closes any further passage of fish up this brook.
