RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Sabbathday Lake.

Fishing in Sabbathday lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation, establishing an open season for fishing in Sabbathday lake from May 1st to September 30th of each year.
