# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to the Issuance of Licenses for Firearms.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 124, § 18, amended.** Section 18 of chapter 124 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding, after the end of the 3rd sentence, 3 new sentences to read as follows:

'The official or officials, issuing a license, shall make a permanent record of it in a suitable book or file, kept for that purpose. Such record shall include date of issuance, the name, age, sex and street address of licensee, together with complete description of weapon, and in case of firearms, the caliber, make and number. As a prerequisite to the issuance of such license, the official or officials may demand a complete set of fingerprints of licensee, to be kept with such permanent record.'
