**AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of the Municipal Court of
Bath.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1937, c. 64, amended. The 2nd sentence of that part designated 'Sec. 2.' of chapter 64 of the private and special laws of 1937, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The judge of said court shall receive from the county of Sagadahoc an annual salary of ~~\$1,650~~ \$2,150 to be paid to him in quarterly payments.'
