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**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Lisbon for Support of Arthur Pulk  
and Carroll Pulk.**

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**Town of Lisbon; appropriation for. Resolved:** That the sum of \$1,723.02 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Lisbon, to reimburse said town for support of Arthur Pulk and Carroll Pulk; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The time this support was furnished to Arthur Pulk and Carroll Pulk was between March 16, 1934 and December 30, 1936, being prior to the period of time that the city of Eastport was taken over by the state. It has been proven that these persons were residents of Eastport during the period of time mentioned.

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
