### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to the Recorder of the Bath Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1937, c. 64, amended. That part designated 'Sec. 2.' of chapter 64 of the private and special laws of 1937, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 2. Qualifications of judge and recorder; salary. Said judge and recorder shall be members a member of the bar of Sagadahoc county, and shall reside during their his continuance in office in said county. The judge of said court shall receive from the county of Sagadahoc an annual salary of \$1,650 to be paid to him in quarterly payments. Said The recorder shall receive from the county of Sagadahoc an annual salary of \$600 to be paid to him in quarterly payments. Both salaries shall be in full for all fees and emoluments of their respective offices.'
