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**AN ACT Relating to the Recorder of the Bath Municipal Court.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1937, c. 64, amended.** That part designated 'Sec. 2.' of chapter 64 of the private and special laws of 1937, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 2. Qualifications of judge and recorder; salary.** Said judge ~~and recorder~~ shall be ~~members~~ a **member** of the bar of Sagadahoc county, and shall reside during ~~their~~ **his** continuance in office in said county. The judge of said court shall receive from the county of Sagadahoc an annual salary of \$1,650 to be paid to him in quarterly payments. ~~Said~~ **The** recorder shall receive from the county of Sagadahoc an annual salary of \$600 to be paid to him in quarterly payments. Both salaries shall be in full for all fees and emoluments of their respective offices.'
