RESOLVE, In Favor of Charles J. Arduini.

Charles J. Arduini; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$255.56 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Charles J. Arduini of Allen Town, Pennsylvania, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his automobile by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On November 15, 1944, a deer jumped from a bank on the driver's left side of the road and into Mr. Arduini's automobile driven by him. Although he applied the brakes immediately, collision was unavoidable. The charge of Rowling's Garage, Rockland, Maine, for such damage as was repaired was \$255.56. Accident occurred on Route No. 1 between Wiscasset and Newcastle, Maine.
