STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

AN ACT Restricting Use of Firearms in the Towns of Deer Isle and Stonington.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 61-C, additional. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 61-C and to read as follows:

'Sec. 61-C. Deer Isle and Stonington, restrictions on guns used in hunting deer. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt deer in the town of Deer Isle and in the town of Stonington, county of Hancock, with any gun other than a shotgun which shall not be larger than 12 gauge.'
