**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Thomas Pond.**

---

**Fishing in Thomas Pond, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Thomas pond in Raymond and Casco to ice fishing for pickerel, white perch, hornpout, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time the ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring and for salmon and trout during February and March.
