RESOLVE, Relating to Retirement Status of Charles Sumner Bates of Pownal.

Resolved: That Charles Sumner Bates of Pownal, an employee of the Pownal State School be, and hereby is, made eligible to become a member of the employees' retirement system of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Charles Sumner Bates was employed by the state for 19 years, 3 months and 25 days prior to 1939 when he resigned. He returned to work at the Pownal State School in January, 1943. He was at that time over 70 years of age, and by virtue of that fact is barred from becoming a member of the retirement system.
