# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT to Create an Airport Commission for the Town of Sanford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Airport commission created. There is hereby created "The Town of Sanford Airport Commission", which shall have the powers and duties as hereinafter set forth.
- Sec. 2. Board of commissioners, etc. The board of selectmen forthwith, after the effective date of this act, shall appoint a Board of Airport Commissioners, consisting of 5 resident citizens of Sanford. In the 1st instance, I member shall be appointed to hold office until February I, 1946; I to hold office until February I, 1947; I to hold office until February I, 1948; I to hold office until February I, 1949, and I to hold office until February I, 1950. At the expiration of each of said terms, a Commissioner shall be appointed for a full term of 5 years. In the case of vacancy in said board, the board of selectmen shall appoint a member thereto for the balance of the unexpired term.
- Sec. 3. Officers, meetings, records. Said Commission shall elect a chairman and secretary annually, establish its own rules for calling and holding meetings, and keep proper records of all of its proceedings. The Commission shall at all times be governed by majority vote of its members.

- Sec. 4. Authority of commission. The Commission shall have full authority over the Sanford Airport and all property connected therewith, subject however, to commitments already made by the town of Sanford and subject to the terms of any grant of any property, included in said airport. The said Airport Commission shall, however, not have authority to dispose of any real estate included in said airport, without previous authority of the town meeting members of said town of Sanford and said Commission shall not have authority to execute any lease of any property under its control for a period of over 5 years.
- **Sec. 5. Expenses.** The said Commissioners shall serve without pay, except for such expenses as may be provided by vote of the town meeting members of the town of Sanford.
