RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Penobscot County to Davidson Land Company.

Forest commissioner authorized to make sale. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to make, execute and deliver to Davidson Land Company a deed in the name of the state, of all interest of the state in the following described property; T. 2, R. 6, W. E. L. S. (Herseytown), Penobscot county, all, with mill, farm and other improvements, but with the exception of lots 12, 36, 108, 119, 120, 131 and 132, and a farm lot, containing 23,491 acres, more or less, for the sum of \$6,308.57.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The interest of Davidson Land Company in T. 2, R. 6, W. E. L. S., Penobscot county was sold to the forest commissioner for a part of the 1940 tax on December 9, 1942. There are unpaid taxes for the years 1940, 1941, 1942 and 1944. The Davidson Land Company offers to pay all unpaid taxes to and including 1944 in the amount of \$6,308.57 which amount includes interest to April 1, 1945. The Davidson Land Company will deposit a certified check with the state treasurer for \$6,308.57 before hearing on the resolve.
