**AN ACT** Relating to a State Police Barrack in the County of Cumberland.

---

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**Sec. 1. Establishment of a barrack.** The governor and council are hereby directed and authorized to purchase such land in the county of Cumberland for the use of the state as may be necessary for the erection of a state police barrack. There shall be erected, equipped, and maintained, under the supervision of the chief of the state police, on said land in the county of Cumberland, a state police barrack.

**Sec. 2. Appropriation.** There is hereby appropriated \$22,500 from the general highway fund and \$2,500 from the general fund for the purchase of said land and the erection and equipping of said barrack.
