RESOLVE, to Provide Funds for Eradication of Bang's Disease, Tuberculosis, and Other Infectious and Contagious Diseases of Livestock.

Eradication of various diseases; appropriation for. Resolved: That the amount of \$500,000 be, and hereby is, provided from the general fund of the state for the eradication of Bang's disease, tuberculosis and other infectious and contagious diseases of livestock. These funds shall be expended under the supervision of the commissioner of agriculture.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The program for the eradication of Bang's disease was started in 1941 and additional funds are necessary to carry on the purpose.
