STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of William Bolduc, of Lewiston.

William Bolduc; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$16.05 from the general fund of the state to be paid to William Bolduc, of Lewiston, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on June 18, 1943, in Caratunk, and was investigated by Game Warden Kenneth E. Gray. The extent of the damage is as follows: left fender bent, left headlights bent and lens broken, hood sprung.
