**RESOLVE, Relating to Reimbursement to James Y. Kinmond of
Westbrook.**

James Y. Kinmond, compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$39.81 to be paid to James Y. Kinmond of Westbrook to compensate Mr. Kinmond in full for all claims against the state, said sum to be paid from the appropriation for the state reformatory for men.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On March 13, 1943 an inmate of the State Reformatory for Men while on escape from that institution stole an automobile, property of James Y. Kinmond and damaged the fender, right headlight, bumper and front of said car in the amount of \$39.81. The repair bill has been paid by Mr. Kinmond and compensation for him is now requested.
